PROGNOSFRUIT 2011 – ONLY TEN DAYS LEFT AT THE PREFERENTIAL RATE!

PROGNOSFRUIT 2011 is organised this year by WAPA (the World Apple and Pear Association) from 4th to 6th August 2011 in Ljubljana (Slovenia). There are now only ten days left to benefit from the preferential registration rate for the conference by logging onto the conference website at www.prognosfruit.eu.

The latest programme updates for the conference can be found in the website. PROGNOSFRUIT will unveil the 2011/2012 apple and pear production forecast and will review market trends in the EU for the category. International developments will also be provided. This year, the conference will also count with presentations on the apple juice market, energy optimisation during fruit storage, an overview of the Slovenian and Balkan fruit production and trade, as well as the presentation by Andrejz Gazowski from the Polish Permanent Representation on the priorities of the EU Polish presidency of the EU during the second semester of 2012. The conference will be opened by the Slovenian State Secretary for Agriculture Tanja Strnisa.

Besides the business programme, PROGNOSFRUIT offers several opportunities for networking, including a welcome cocktail at the Town Hall of Ljubljana, a gala dinner in the Museum of Modern Art, and a technical visit to the region of Krško, including visits to apple and pears orchards and facilities, with lunch at a local winery.

PROGNOSFRUIT is this year taking take place for the first time ever in Slovenia. Hans Van Es, COPA COGECA, co-organiser of the conference, stated: "PROGNOSFRUIT is a well established event on the agenda of the European apple and pear production. PROGNOSFRUIT is celebrating this year its 35th edition, demonstrating the tradition and excellence of this unique conference. Slovenia is innovative as a venue for the conference and will allow delegates to discover a new apple and pear destination within the European environment."
